

## **Associate Membership at New College MCR**

### **Eligibility**

Any person working at Oxford University in an academic capacity who is not already a member of a College or PPH is eligible to apply for Associate Membership to the New College MCR. Students from St. Stephen's House and Wycliffe Hall are invited to apply with the assent of their establishments. The New College MCR will permit up to twenty Associate Members to join at any one time.

### **Entitlement/Regulations**

- Associate Members are entitled to the following privileges: meals in hall, MCR guest nights (every other Friday in term), all MCR social events, use of the MCR computer room, access to and use of the Middle Common Room in the Weston building, use of the College bar and JCR pantry, and participation in MCR sporting events. They are **not** entitled to: use of the College library, College rooms for parties or other events, invitations to "hospitality" events sponsored by the College (including but not limited to events hosted by the Tutor for Graduates), and College accommodation (unless there is a surplus of vacancies).
- Associate Members are subject to any relevant College regulations. And the College holds the right to terminate the arrangement at any given time, making an appropriate refund of the fee paid only after battel charges have been fully met.
- The Associate Members must pay £240 a year or £80.00 per term before membership can be activated. The money is to be credited to the MCR account, and all battels incurred by said members must be met before membership is renewed.

### **Application Procedure**

After downloading and completing this form, attach a copy of your CV and a letter explaining why you wish to have associate membership of the MCR and send it to the President of the MCR for confirmation. Once the MCR President and the Tutor for Graduates confirm the application, you will be asked for the above-stated payment.

As soon as the MCR verifies receipt of the form and payment, we will add you to our list of members, send a list of social events for the term, and you will then be entitled to all rights as an Associate Member.
